



- a** Original research abstracts must follow IMRAD format: Introduction, Objectives, Materials & Methods, Results, Conclusion.
- a** Minimum 3 keywords and maximum 5 keywords only.
- a** No images, graphs, or tables allowed inside the abstract.
- a** Presentation Rules Oral presentation: Microsoft PowerPoint, max 7 minutes (5 min presentation + 2 min discussion).
- a** Poster presentation: Bring physical poster, maximum time 5 minutes (3 min presentation + 2 min discussion).
- a** Important Notes Abstract must be submitted through the provided link/form.
- a** Last date for submission: _____ Decision of acceptance/rejection will be sent via email. Only one oral and one poster presentation allowed per registered delegate.

Musical Legacy




Location



Distance: 75 km from Khandwa




MAHESHWAR FORT

Historic fort town on the banks of Narmada, known for its beautiful ghats, temples, and handloom sarees. The fort was the capital of the Holkar dynasty.




